The average population of 23 Calgary divisions is 42 952 which when compared the the general average of 37 820 indicates that Calgary should have $(42952-37820) \times 23 / 37820 = 3$ more electoral divisions. Edmonton has an average of 40576 for 18 divisions which could afford them one more division.

Both cities appear to be under-represented compared to the rural divisions and Calgary appears to get the worst treatment of all.

Are you going to address this discrepancy in representation?

Would you consider adding more seats?
