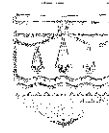

**Re: Review of Electoral Divisions**

In response to your August 28 letter requesting participation and input on the Electoral Divisions, this letter offers the input of St. Albert City Council.

First, with a population of about 60,000, St. Albert is poised to need two MLA's soon, if not now. As such, our request is that this be planned for accordingly.

Secondly, the dividing line for our city is not clear to the average constituent and must be changed. There are two natural dividers in our city; one being St. Albert Trail (east divides west), and the Sturgeon River (north divides south). It is very important that one of these two boundary dividers is chosen. Today, it is confusing to many residents as the current division does not make for clear MLA delineation or definition.
