Thank you for your letter of August 28th in which you described the work of the Alberta Electoral Boundaries Commission 2009/10 and introduced members of the Commission.

In your letter, you advised that the Commission will be reviewing the area, boundaries and names of the electoral divisions in the province and proposing changes within the guidelines provided in the *Electoral Boundaries Commission Act* and a that final report will be submitted to the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly by July 2010.

We are pleased to participate in the process of public consultation in the electoral map of the province and have discussed the merits of introducing two additional seats to be included in the Capital City, Edmonton.

Edmonton has grown significantly since the last electoral boundaries were established. We respectfully request, therefore, that you advance to the Commission our position that two of the four additional seats be included in the Capital City of Edmonton.

This process is very important. Thank you for inviting input from Albertans and from the Board of Trustees of Edmonton Catholic Schools.
