The very northeast corner of ED 61 Lacombe-Ponoka includes the people who live on the northeast shores of Dried Meat Lake. These people do all of their business in Camrose and area, their children attend Camrose schools yet they are expected to vote for a representative from Ponoka area whom they have never met and who certainly doesn't bother to call on this little remote (even removed geographically) area from their constituency. It would make much more sense for that small area in the northeast corner of the Lacombe-Ponoka electoral district to belong to the Wetaskiwin-Camrose Electoral District with which they have contacts and familiarity and because of the natural boundaries of the lake and hence roads and distances.

Please consider changes to these two electoral districts to better accomodate the population in this area and allow for a more informed voting process as well.
