The Council of the Municipal District of Greenview has received the interim report of the Electoral Boundaries Commission, and has a number of serious concerns regarding the probable negative impacts of the proposed electoral boundary revisions on the MD of Greenview, the County of Grande Prairie, the City of Grande Prairie, and other municipalities surrounding the City. Various area communities, as well as the Grande Prairie Chamber of Commerce, have indicated that they are in opposition to the proposed changes due to these shared concerns.

Accordingly, the Council of the Municipal District is asking the Commission to ensure that at least one of the public hearings planned for April 12th and 30th be held in the Grande Prairie area, to ensure that all of the affected parties are able to make adequate representation on this matter at that hearing.
